# **Baroque Flamenco Reference Script**

First just practice the Intro, then then first 2 sections, then all 4. If this script makes sense to you, use it – if not, make one that makes sense to YOU. I made the sections red that I might have to focus on remembering

### [INTRO]

Raise G# Lever (below middle C)

- LH Fingers on (D-F-A)-C => STRUM
- Fingers move to: (C-E-G)-C => STRUM
- Fingers move to: (D-F-A)-C => STRUM
- [TRANSITION] Gliss and Lower G Lever

### [MELODY & BLOWING]

- MELODY
- **BLOWING\*** (Am G F E EAB) (transition: on last F & E gliss)
- MELODY
- **BLOWING\* (Am G F E** EAB)
- [TRANSITION repeated chord] F-E-F-E (F-F-F-F)
- **E** (RAISE THE G# as you play the note)

# **[CADENZA]** (E => F) (with G#s) Play all, any part – or none of these:

- Option #1: Fingered Arpeggios: E (E-G#-B-E) F (E-A-C-F) E (E-G#-B-E)
- Option #2: Percussion: LH: ||: BDE ACF :|| (RH Percussion)
- Option #3: Strums (Fingered &/or Fingernail):

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||: LH damp (D-F-A)-\underline{C} => STRUM ~ Move fingers (C-E-G)-\underline{C} => STRUM :||
Move fingers: (D-F-A)-C => STRUM
[Transition - gliss] (leave G#)
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# [MELODY & ENDING]

- MELODY
- ENDING (A minor: C-E-A) Gliss Down Low A

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<sup>\*</sup>Blowing is the jazz term for improvising, so this could be considered a 'Blowing Section'
