

# Claire de Lune

In the workshop, one of the things we'll do is look at how we can create a 'complete' version of Claire de Lune using the power of patterns

At the end of each extender, you can:

1. Repeat the Extender
2. Go back to the tune
3. Go on to another extender

Don't worry if the rhythms in the melody seem complex. We'll look at it in terms of pattern in the workshop

(The Very last time go to Coda)

Note: I put the improvs in 3/4 just so they're easier to see. You don't have to change your rhythm
